ABSTRACT

The Water4All Partnership - Water Security for the Planet, co-funded by the European Union under the Horizon Europe Programme, aims to ensure long-term water security through systemic transformations and innovations in freshwater research and innovation. The partnership addresses critical water challenges, promoting sustainable water management practices and innovative solutions.

As part of its commitment to fostering international cooperation, Water4All's Task E.1 focuses on developing an international strategy to identify geographical and thematic priorities for multilateral development cooperation. This report maps programmes managed by major international organizations investing in the water sector. The mapping includes programmes addressing freshwater issues from the perspectives of energy, climate, and environment.

The methodology involved a desk research of websites from ten major organizations contributing to water-related projects, with data collection spanning from August 2023 to April 2024. The result is a summary table of 285 active projects and programmes, detailing names, estimated costs, target destinations, objectives, and links.

Key findings reveal that Africa and Asia receive the majority of funding, with significant investments directed towards India and China. The World Bank leads in the number of supported projects, followed by the Asian Development Bank. The analysis highlights financial priorities and strategic focuses, emphasizing the need for consistent and detailed data.

Recommendations include improving data collection mechanisms, expanding the scope to cover more institutions and regions, and incorporating feedback from Water4All partners. Regular updates and future deliverables will refine the mapping to better support Water4All's goal of achieving global water security.

This mapping of water-related international programmes serves as a foundational step in enhancing international cooperation, aligning with the Water4All objective of driving impactful water management practices worldwide.

1. INTRODUCTION

The Water4All Partnership -Water Security for the Planet (www.water4all-partnership.eu) is co-funded by the European Union within the frame of the Horizon Europe programme. Water4All is a funding programme for Research and Innovation (R&I) scientific research in freshwater. **It aims to ensure long-term water security for all by driving systemic transformations and advancements across the water R&I landscape and fostering connections between problem owners and solution providers.** The Partnership addresses critical water challenges through an integrated approach, promoting sustainable water management practices and innovative solutions that are essential for environmental sustainability, economic growth, and social well-being.

Beyond launching Joint Transnational Calls for R&I projects, Water4All offers a comprehensive portfolio of activities. These **activities include the alignment of water programmes across different regions and sectors, demonstration projects** that showcase innovative water technologies and practices, **and international cooperation initiatives** that enhance global water management efforts. The partnership also focuses on the wide transfer and dissemination of activities and results to ensure that the knowledge and innovations developed are accessible to a broad audience. Additionally, Water4All emphasizes the importance of networking and capacity building to strengthen the capabilities of stakeholders involved in water management.

As part of its commitment to fostering international cooperation, the **Partnership has mandated Water4All partners involved in Pillar E that focuses on enhancing international cooperation and developing a comprehensive strategy for addressing global water challenges.** The objectives of Pillar E include raising the level of engagement among countries, enhancing cooperation between EU and international initiatives, and expanding co-design and collaboration in a flexible manner. It also aims to attract new partners to create the necessary critical mass for developing and implementing innovative solutions. Ultimately, Pillar E aspires to establish Water4All as the central coordination and strategic portal for tackling global water challenges. Pillar E consists of three different Tasks.

- Task E.1 focuses on developing and approving the Water4All international strategy, which aims to identify geographical and thematic priorities for multilateral development cooperation. It leverages the expertise from Water JPI and the IC4Water CSA to enhance international cooperation agreements and foster new partnerships in water-related R&I programmes. This study falls under Task E.1.
- Task E.2 aims to support and monitor the achievement of United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs). These activities will be initiated and implemented in the next work programme linked to the second phase of the partnership, from June 2024 onwards.
- Task E.3 aims to develop, test, and implement new tools and approaches for international cooperation on water-related issues in the R&I and Business-to-Business - B2B sectors. This includes cooperation projects within water utilities, support for co-creation of living labs and demonstration sites, international trade shows, and calls for projects designed for non-member countries.

During the implementation phase of Water4All, Pillar E activities were initially divided into three Task Forces (TF): *TF Strategy*, *TF Events*, and *TF Documents*. *TF Strategy*, led by partner CNR, was responsible for preparing the international strategy for the Water4All partnership. *TF Events*, led by partner VITO, managed the presentation of the partnership at international conferences and exhibitions. *TF Documents*, led by partner CREA, was responsible for mapping international agreements with non-EU countries and water-related international programmes.

In this research, the **focus is on identifying projects and programmes addressing freshwater issues** from the perspective of energy, climate and environmental. The word 'project' in this report refers to a project and/or a programme. The objectives of some projects included improving access to drinking water, enhancing water supply to agricultural land, increasing access to safely managed water and sanitation services, improving flood risk management, optimizing water management, monitoring wastewater, among others.

Desk research of the websites of ten organizations that make significant contributions to projects was conducted by CREA, which consulted the process at monthly meetings with partners from the *TF Documents*, with the data collection process running from August 2023 to April 2024 and becoming more intensive towards the end of the period. **The outcome is a summary table of 285 active projects and international programmes**, encompassing project names, estimated costs, target destinations, main objectives, as well as project links.

The collected data serves as a foundation for enhancing the effectiveness and reach of Water4All's international cooperation initiatives and International Strategy, ultimately contributing to the goal of the partnership, which is achieving water security for all in long term.

The aim was to map projects and programmes that focus on topics related to freshwater. The projects were classified according to the institutions that invested in this sector, whereas ten of those were selected for this study:

- International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN)
- United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO)
- United Nations Development Programme (UNDP)
- United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund (UNICEF)
- World Health Organization (WHO)
- The World Bank (WB)
- European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD)
- European Investment Bank (EIB)
- Asian Development Bank (ADB)
- African Development Bank Group (AfDB)

For some programmes, it was challenging to track down specific information because each institution's website is different. Additionally, not all institutions published comprehensive details. Therefore, **the data should be considered incomplete in some respects**, as it was not possible to gather all the necessary details.

For example, the WASH project is supported by both UNICEF and WHO. This large-scale project operates in many countries, classifying it as a global initiative. However, clear budget information for this project is not available.

Using the overview spreadsheet, several charts were created to illustrate the results from various perspectives.

2. METHODOLOGY

The methodology for collecting data and selecting international institutions and projects for the mapping study involved several key steps:

Data collection:

- Desk research was conducted on the websites of ten organizations that make significant contributions to freshwater projects. This effort was led by CREA, which consulted with *TF Documents* partners at monthly meetings. Data collection ran from August 2023 to April 2024, intensifying towards the end of the period. The selection of organizations depended on their size and, in the case of UNESCO and the World Bank, on pre-existing contacts established by Water4All partners. In addition, the selection was influenced by discussions among the partners of the *TF Documents*.
- Information was gathered on project names, estimated costs, target destinations, main objectives, and relevant project references. Projects were selected that address freshwater issues with an emphasis on energy, climate, and environment. Priority was given to projects with significant potential impact and projects that are in line with the strategic objectives of the Water4All programme. For some programmes, it was challenging to track down specific information due to differences in how institutions present data on their websites.
- Using the overview spreadsheet, several charts were created to illustrate the results from various perspectives. These visualizations help in understanding the geographical and thematic distribution of the projects and programmes.
- After completing the mapping and document, the draft report was sent to all Pillar E partners for review. Comments were received and either implemented or will be addressed in the next update.

The choice of organizations depended on the size of the organization and, in the case of UNESCO and the World Bank, also on the contacts already established by Water4All partners. Additionally, the selection was based on discussions within the partners of *TF Documents*. In the feedback from other partners of Task E.1, it was requested to expand these institutions, which will be attempted in the update of the mapping to be carried out during the second phase of activities of the Partnership and expected for publication by May 2026.

3. RESULTS OF THE MAPPING OF INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS AND PROGRAMMES

A. Geographical distribution of institutional investments

TOTAL VOLUME IN % DISTRIBUTION BY CONTINENT




FIGURE 1 – TOTAL VOLUME IN % DISTRIBUTION BY CONTINENT

Figure 1 provides a detailed breakdown of the investment amounts by region, highlighting the geographical allocation of funds from the selected institutions. **The data reveals a significant concentration of investments directed towards Africa and Asia, indicating a strategic focus on these regions.** This distribution underscores the institutions' priorities in targeting growth and development opportunities within these continents.




FIGURE 2- DISTRIBUTION OF VOLUME IN MILLIONS EUR IN THE ASIA

Figure 2 provides a comprehensive breakdown of investments in Asia, detailing the amounts allocated to individual countries. It specifically highlights those countries where investments exceeded 500 million Euros, thereby identifying the primary recipients of substantial funding. **The data clearly demonstrates that India and China are the dominant destinations for these investments,** attracting the majority of the capital.

In contrast, investments in other countries within the region, each amounting to less than 500 million Euros, are grouped together under the category 'Other countries in Asia', reflecting a relatively lower level of investment in these nations.

Figures 1 and 2 highlight the focus of development projects by the selected institutions, demonstrating a **significant emphasis on Africa and Asia.** Figure 1 illustrates that these regions attract the majority of project funding, underscoring a prioritization of development opportunities. In Figure 2, **India and China emerge as the primary recipients of projects in terms of total volume,** whereas other Asian countries receive comparatively fewer projects measured by volume in millions EUR.

NUMBER OF PROJECTS BY CONTINENT




FIGURE 3 - NUMBER OF PROJECTS BY CONTINENT

In the Figure 3, the number of supported projects is categorized by continent. **The data reaffirm the findings depicted in the initial graph, emphasizing a predominant allocation of funding towards Africa and Asia.** Specifically, Asia received support for 119 projects, while Africa benefited from 85 supported projects. In the aggregate graph, the project counts for China and India have been omitted from the Asia total due to their considerably higher numbers compared to any other country, necessitating a separate scale.

B. Project distribution by institution and focus

NUMBER OF PROJECTS BY INSTITUTIONS




FIGURE 4 - NUMBER OF PROJECTS BY INSTITUTIONS

In the following Figure 4, the number of projects per institution is detailed. **Leading the list is the World Bank with 115 projects, followed by the Asian Development Bank with 61 projects.** It's crucial to emphasize that these projects are selected based on specific strategic objectives.

One notable programme, WASH, supported by the World Health Organization and UNICEF, presents a unique case as it comprises a large-scale global initiative spanning multiple countries. Due to the absence of detailed sub-project data, it has not been included in the current analysis.

VOLUME IN MILLIONS EUR BY INSTITUTIONS




FIGURE 5 - VOLUME IN MILLIONS EUR BY INSTITUTIONS

In the Figure 5, an overview of investment amounts from various institutions is presented. However, the investment from the WASH project, supported by WHO and UNICEF, is not included, resulting in a depiction of only 8 institutions. **The World Bank stands out as the largest investor, followed by significant contributions from the Asian Development Bank, the African Development Bank, and the European Investment Bank.**

NUMBER OF PROJECTS BY VOLUME IN MILLIONS EUR

In the upcoming figure, a **detailed overview of projects is provided, categorized according to their respective budget ranges.** The classification includes six distinct categories: projects with budgets ranging from €0.5 million to €0.9 million, €1 million to €9.9 million, €10 million to €39.9 million, €40 million to €99.9 million, €100 million to €249.9 million, and those exceeding €250 million. This structured approach enables a thorough evaluation of each project's magnitude and complexity based on its allocated budget. **Such categorization is essential for understanding the financial scale and scope of initiatives undertaken by various institutions or organizations.**




FIGURE 6 - NUMBER OF PROJECTS BY VOLUME IN MILLIONS EUR

Following, projects were analysed, based on their respective budget range, focusing on **four main investors: the World Bank (WB), the Asian Development Bank (ADB), the African Development Bank (AfDB), and the European Investment Bank (EIB).** By examining the distribution of projects according to the budgets of these investors, an overview of their financial contributions and priorities, within the overall project landscape, is derived.




FIGURE 7 - NUMBER OF PROJECTS OF ASIAN DEVELOPMENT BANK BY VOLUME IN MILLIONS EUR




FIGURE 8 - NUMBER OF PROJECTS OF AFRICAN DEVELOPMENT BANK BY VOLUME IN MILLIONS EUR




FIGURE 9 - NUMBER OF PROJECTS OF EUROPEAN INVESTMENT BANK BY VOLUME IN MILLIONS EUR




FIGURE 10 - NUMBER OF PROJECTS OF WORLD BANK BY VOLUME IN MILLIONS EUR

Following figures 7, 8, 9 and 10 illustrate number of projects of four major investors categorized by the budget ranges.

The African Development Bank focuses on smaller to mid-sized projects with no investments over 250 million, the Asian Development Bank has a balanced distribution with significant investments in higher budget categories, the European Investment Bank concentrates on mid to high budget projects with none under 10 million, and the World Bank demonstrates a strong capacity for large-scale investments with many projects in the higher budget categories.

NUMBER OF PROJECTS OF ASIAN DEVELOPMENT BANK BY VOLUME IN MILLIONS EUR

NUMBER OF PROJECTS OF AFRICAN DEVELOPMENT BANK BY VOLUME IN MILLIONS EUR

NUMBER OF PROJECTS OF EUROPEAN INVESTMENT BANK BY VOLUME IN MILLIONS EUR

NUMBER OF PROJECTS OF WORLD BANK BY VOLUME IN MILLIONS EUR

4. KEY FINDINGS AND LIMITS

Water4All's comprehensive analysis highlights the strategic focus and financial priorities of major institutions investing in water-related projects, particularly in Africa and Asia. The detailed examination of the distribution and scope of these projects across various budget ranges provides valuable insights into the financial contributions and strategic directions of these key investors.

The analysis reveals that the **majority of funding is directed towards Africa and Asia, indicating that these regions are prioritized for water-related development projects**. Within Asia, **India and China receive the highest investments**, reflecting their significant need for improvements in water security. This geographical allocation underscores the strategic focus on addressing critical water challenges in these regions.

The World Bank leads with the highest number of supported projects (115), followed by the Asian Development Bank (61), showcasing their robust involvement in water-related initiatives. **The African Development Bank focuses on smaller to mid-sized projects**, with no investments exceeding 250 million Euros. In contrast, **the Asian Development Bank exhibits a balanced distribution of projects** across various budget categories, including significant investments in higher budget ranges. **The European Investment Bank concentrates on mid to high budget projects**, with none under 10 million Euros, indicating a preference for substantial investments. **World Bank seems to be leading the race of investments in the water domain.**

Projects are categorized into six budget ranges: €0.5 - €0.9 million, €1 - €9.9 million, €10 - €39.9 million, €40 - €99.9 million, €100 - €249.9 million, and over €250 million. **This structured categorization enables a clear understanding of the financial scale and complexity of initiatives undertaken by various institutions.** Figures 7, 8, 9, and 10 illustrate the number of projects funded by the four major investors, categorized by these budget ranges, providing a visual representation of their financial contributions and strategic priorities.

The availability and completeness of project data varied across institutions, with some providing more detailed information than others. **This inconsistency poses challenges in fully capturing the scope of investments and project details.** For example, the WASH project, supported by WHO and UNICEF, is a significant global initiative but lacks detailed budget information, highlighting gaps in available data for some large-scale projects.

One notable programme is the WASH project, supported by the World Health Organization and UNICEF. This large-scale global initiative spans multiple countries, presenting a unique case in the analysis. However, due to the absence of detailed sub-project data, it has not been included in the current analysis, which underscores the need for comprehensive data and transparent reporting to better understand and optimize these efforts.

This mapping underscores the importance of targeted investments and strategic priorities in addressing global water security challenges. By focusing on regions and projects with the greatest need and potential impact, these institutions are driving significant advancements in sustainable water management practices. **However, the findings also emphasize the need for more consistent and detailed data** to fully capture and evaluate the scope and effectiveness of these initiatives.

5. CONCLUSION AND NEXT STEPS

In conclusion, the Water4All Partnership, co-funded by the European Union under Horizon Europe, is pivotal in advancing global water security through innovative research and international collaboration. By aligning regional and sectoral efforts, Water4All drives systemic changes in freshwater management. The analysis reveals a strong investment focus on Africa and Asia region, with key players like the World Bank and Asian Development Bank leading numerous projects/programmes. However, inconsistencies in data availability, such as the lack of detailed budget information for large-scale projects like WASH, highlight the need for improved transparency. Future work should focus on refining data collection and reporting to optimize the impact of this mapping.

Given the limitations identified in this initial mapping study, such as incomplete data and difficulties in obtaining detailed information, the following steps are proposed for future updates:

- Improved data collection mechanisms and expanded datasets.
- Expanding the scope: extending the coverage to other institutions and regions and capturing a wider range of projects and initiatives to provide a more comprehensive overview.
- Build on feedback from Water4All partners and expand the study to include recommended organisations.
- Regular updates: schedule regular updates to the mapping study to include new data and reflect changes in international water cooperation initiatives (living document accessible for updates within Water4All's collaborative platform).
- Consult newly collected data with Task Force Document partners.
- Future deliverables: Prepare a major update of the report that incorporates new findings and feedback from this initial study. Achieve a more detailed and accurate mapping of international water cooperation initiatives by May 2026. In the long term, the document will continue to be updated in the future, with a new release foreseen in May 2028.
